**Solomon Odero (Chula, 2020)**

Executive Director of Day Africa has been training Kenyan women and children in job skills, employment skills and micro-enterprise for 10 years. He is working with Rotarians in Kenya and the US to grow and diversify these essential services.



**Scott Martin (Chula, 2017)**

Global Partnerships Manager with Mediators Beyond Borders International works on every continent. Among his many projects, he combines his backgrounds in landscaping and social entrepreneurship to build bridges in Trinidad and Tobago between the local population, Rotarians, and Venezuelan refugees.



**Dr. Sellah King'oro (Chula, 2016)**

Senior Gender Advisor, of the British Peace Support Team Africa is a peace and security analyst, trainer, and gender specialist.
